Storage Boxes for Classroom Use





Some class teachers encourage pupils to use storage boxes to store their books and copies neatly in the classroom. Every evening, before they go home, pupils are requested to place their chairs and storage boxes on top of their desks to facilitate cleaning of the classroom floors.


Due to space restrictions on the pupils' tables and in the interest of health and safety, boxes of books <u>must</u> be stored <u>under</u> the chairs as shown above. (If not stored safely, falling boxes of books are very likely to cause injury.)

The dimensions of the maximum size of storage box which can be accommodated under the school chairs are as follows: 40cm x 30cm x 20cm (16 to 18 litre capacity should be ideal.)


Therefore, for the sake of convenience for your child and the safety of all the pupils in the class, it is imperative that you take this maximum size into consideration when purchasing a storage box for your child for school. Lids are not required.
